



1 Cookie Enabling in different Browsers

1.1. Internet Explorer 10

1. Click on the **Tools icon**  on the very right a (or Tools in the menu bar).
2. Choose **Internet Options**.
3. Then click on the **Security** tab.
4. In the Privacy section, choose **Medium** or lower.
5. Click **OK** to save your options.



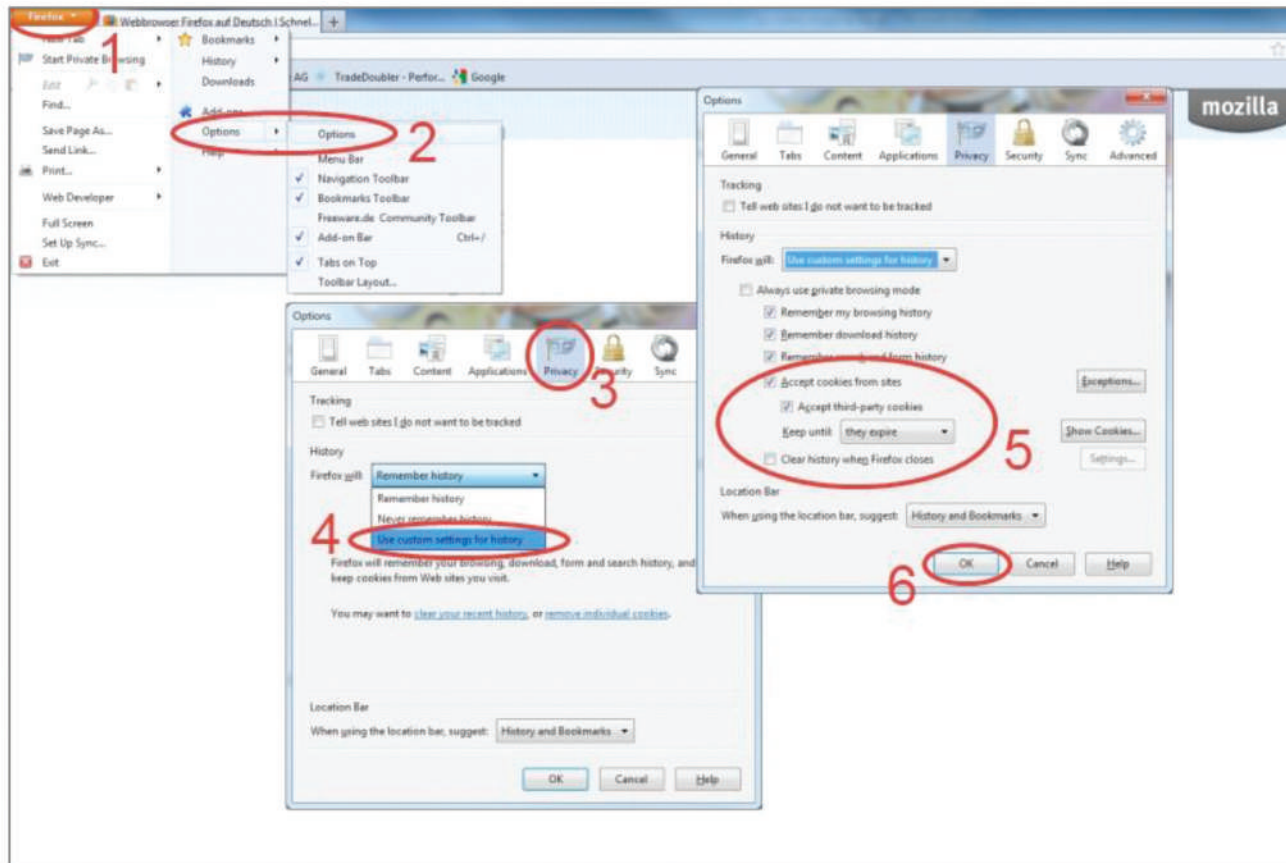

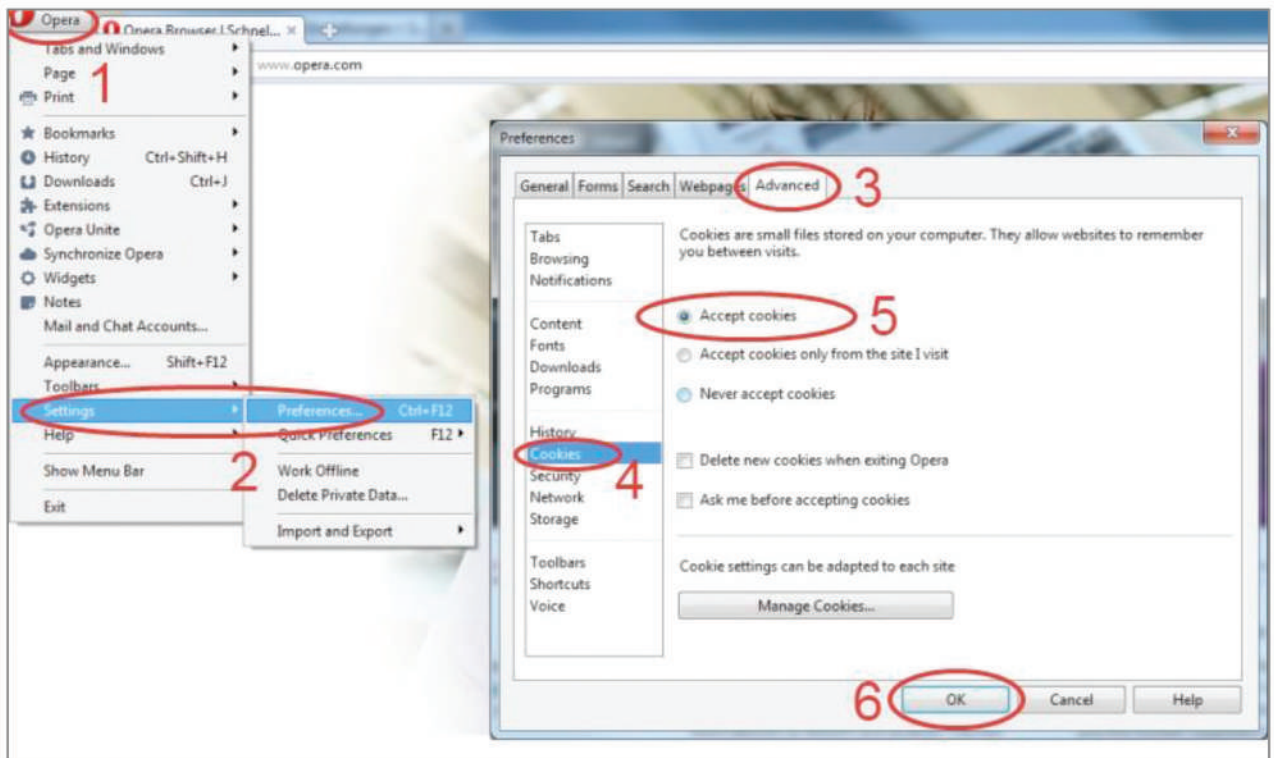
1.2. Mozilla Firefox 21

1. At the top of the Firefox window, click on the **Firefox button** (or Tools in the menu bar).
2. Choose **Options** (Preferences on Mac).
3. Select the **Privacy** panel.
4. Set **Firefox will to Use custom settings for history**.
5. Check mark **Accept cookies from sites** to enable Cookies.
6. Click **OK** to close the Options window.




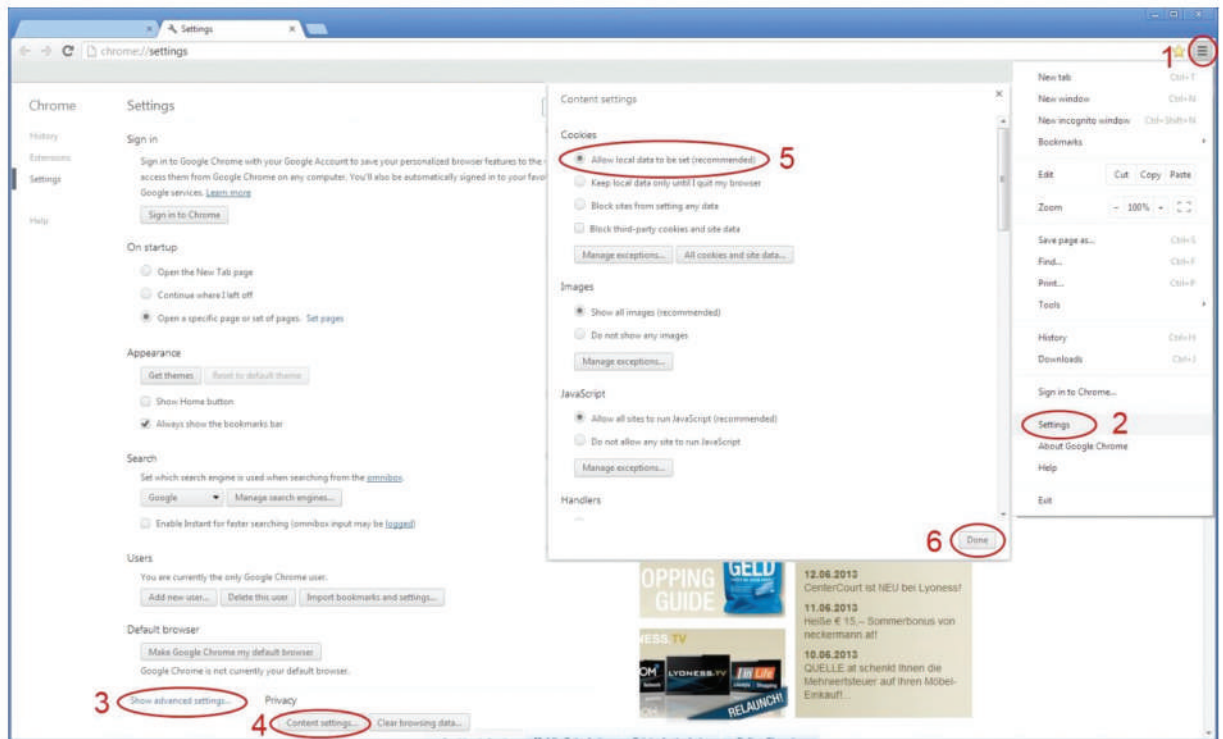
1.3. Opera 12

1. Click the **Opera** button in the left corner (or Tools in the menu bar).
2. Choose **Preferences** in the drop-down menu.
3. When the Preferences box appears, click on the **Advanced** tab.
4. On the left side of the box choose **Cookies**.
5. Then select **Accept cookies**.
6. Click **OK** to finish and to save your options.




1.4. Google Chrome 27

1. Click the icon  on the browser toolbar.
2. Select **Settings**.
3. Click on **Show advanced settings**.
4. In the **Privacy** section click **Content settings**.
5. Make sure **Allow local data to be set** is selected.
6. Click **Done** in order to save it.



1.5. Safari 5

1. Click on the **Tools icon**  on the very right (or tools in the menu bar).
2. Select the **Preferences** from the drop down menu.
3. Select the **Privacy** tab.
4. Set **Block Cookies** to **Never**.
